Spellings

The children will be focussing on a spelling rule each week in class, completing a series of activities designed to embed the rule before completing a short test on Fridays. A copy of the spelling rules for this half term will be sent home with the children. The results of the spelling tests will be recorded in their reading records each week.

Reading Books

Please send book bags in every Friday so we can change your child's reading book. Library books will be changed on a Wednesday. Children are expected to read at least three times (days) per week and record this in their reading records. Reading can be recorded in reading records by anyone who reads with them e.g. parents, grandparents, older siblings etc. Raffle tickets are given out as rewards for reading at least 3 times every week (and for every subsequent day of reading). The reading raffle is drawn on a Friday in Celebration Assembly.
